The Welding Journal Research Supplement (WJRS) is seeking manuscripts for rapid publication of **emerging research that is cutting-edge and novel**.

The manuscripts are relatively short in length and are called *WJRS Letters*. They aim to allow authors to quickly publish new research results on "hot" topic areas of interest to the welding community.

WJRS Letters are not intended to be data dumps or an option for publication of low-quality research. Only manuscripts that describe new, cutting-edge research will be accepted.

The details for submission are as follows:

- (1) Click here to see the guidelines/template to prepare the manuscript.
- (2) The article's content must fit into **five pages** when laid out in the *WJRS Letters* template without format changes to be published. Manuscripts require brief, focused communication with the following sections: **Introduction/Background/Objectives, Procedures, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, and Limited References.**
- **(3)** Submit *WJRS Letters* manuscripts via **Editorial Manager**. After creating an account and logging in as an author, click on "New Submissions" and then "Submit New Manuscript":
