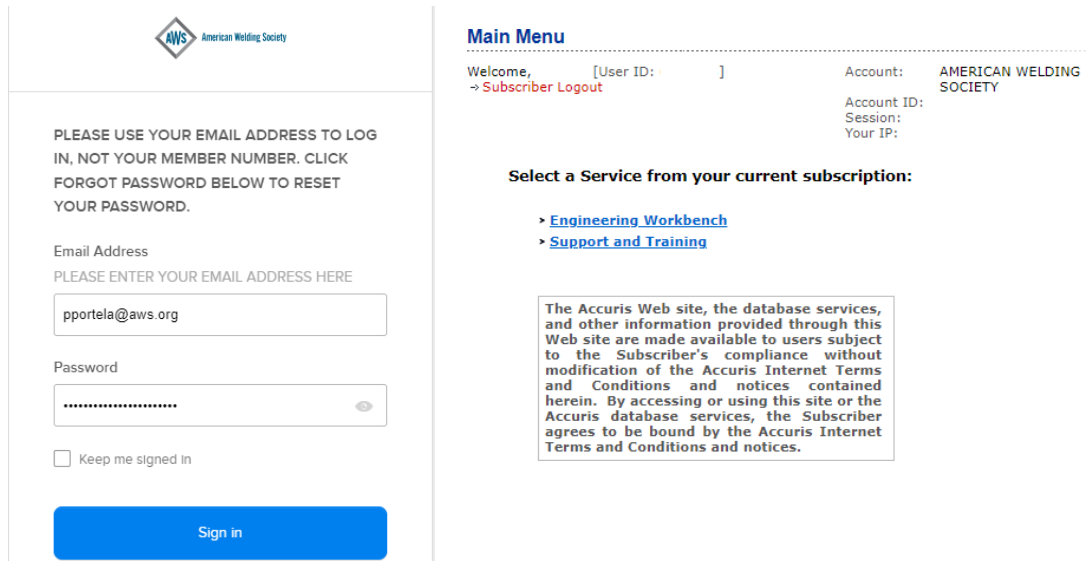


Engineering Workbench: AWS Committee Access for Codes and Standards

To access Engineering Workbench (EWB): <https://weld.ng/ewb>

You will login using your AWS credentials from signin.aws.org (left image), then click *Engineering Workbench* (right image) to be redirected to the platform.

If you do not know your login, you can click *Forgot Password* and enter the email address associated with your Committee work (i.e. Specbuilder). If you have any issues finding that email address, you can email your Committee Secretary.

When you click to access the standard, you will receive a notice with details on using FileOpen (only required for offline viewing of a PDF, or printing). Click accept to continue into EWB.

If your company is a current subscriber of EWB, you will need to toggle between accounts to ensure you are accessing the AWS volunteer version. Click [here](#) for instructions.

Once you are logged in, you can search for any AWS standard using the search bar. From within the standard in EWB, you can annotate, share links to portions of the document (the individual it is shared with will be required to login using the method above), bookmark, compare with previous editions of the standard, and more.

Instructions for Offline Access or Printing:

Notes (offline PDF only):

- You are required to download the free plug-in to view any secured electronic AWS publication. There is no limit to the number of times a document may be viewed on your computer.
- The AWS publication is "locked" to the computer on which it was first opened. Once an electronic AWS publication has been locked to a computer, it can only be opened from that computer.
- The ability to copy and paste text from the electronic document has been disabled.

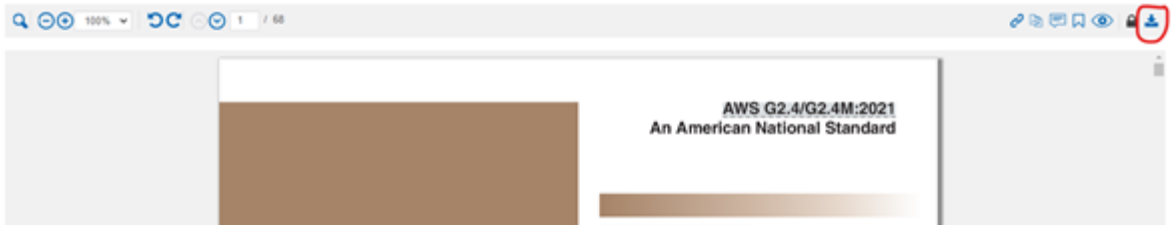
Download FileOpen at <http://plugin.fileopen.com/getplugin.asp?bhcp=1>

1. Ensure your browser is set to **download** PDFs, not open within the browser. This will ensure FileOpen functions properly and will open your secure PDF once it is downloaded.

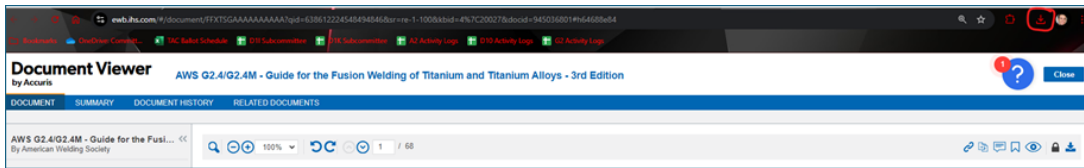

When the document opens, click on the download icon on the top right of the document (see illustration below, icon is circled in red):



Once it downloads (circled in red, below, is where you access downloads in Chrome), you may open the file in your PDF Viewer. Note that if Engineering Workbench is asking for a password, you don't need to input one as you have already downloaded the document.



For Current EWB Subscribers :

- If your company is a current subscriber of EWB, you will need to toggle between accounts to ensure you are accessing the AWS volunteer version.
- You can do this by clicking *Change Account* (shown in blue in the image below). From that screen, you will be able to select between all your available accounts.
