<b>ELIHU THOMSON RESISTANCE WELDING AWARD</b>	December 31 <sup>st</sup>	<p>This award is administered by the American Welding Society and sponsored by the Resistance Welding Manufacturing Alliance (RWMA). It was established in 1985, during RWMA's 50th anniversary, for initial presentation in 1986 to celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the invention of resistance welding.
