OTHER AWS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

WELDING COMPETITION SCHOLARSHIPS

Each AWS District has scholarship funds to award to winners of local welding competitions. Competitions are chosen by the District Director and District leadership.

CAREERS IN WELDING TOP SCORE SCHOLARSHIP

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

For students who reside and attend school internationally – they can apply for our International Scholarship.

WELDING EDUCATOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are available for welding instructors to pursue professional development courses or to use for an advanced degree.

AWS Foundation Grants

WELDING WORKFORCE GRANT

Grants up to \$25,000 are available for secondary and post-secondary education/training institutions to enhance and improve welding programs resulting in an increase in the number of welding graduates and/or the number of graduates successfully placed in welding or welding-related jobs. Schools must be AWS Educational Institution Members to apply.

LIGHT A SPARK GRANT

Miller® and the AWS Foundation have partnered to establish the Light a Spark Grant. This grant provides a starter package of equipment and supplies to introduce welding into a high school Ag-Ed Program, Career and Technical Education Class, or Practical Skills Course. Up to 10 starter packages valued at more than \$10,000 each will be awarded annually.
